

Guidelines for Allocation of Hostel Accommodation

- **Eligibility Criteria-** Admission to the college: Students must have been admitted to the college through a regular admission process.
 - Course duration: Students must be pursuing a full-time course in the college.
 - Distance from home: Priority may be given to students who are from outside the local area or have difficulty in communicating.
- **Application Process-** Application form: Students must submit a completed application form for hostel accommodation.
 - Required documents: Students must submit required documents, such as proof of admission, identity proof, and income certificate (if applicable).
 - Application deadline: Applications must be submitted by the specified deadline.
- **Allocation Process-** Merit-based allocation: Hostel seats may be allocated based on merit, with priority given to students from disadvantaged backgrounds or those with disabilities.
 - First-come, first-served basis: Hostel seats may be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to availability.
