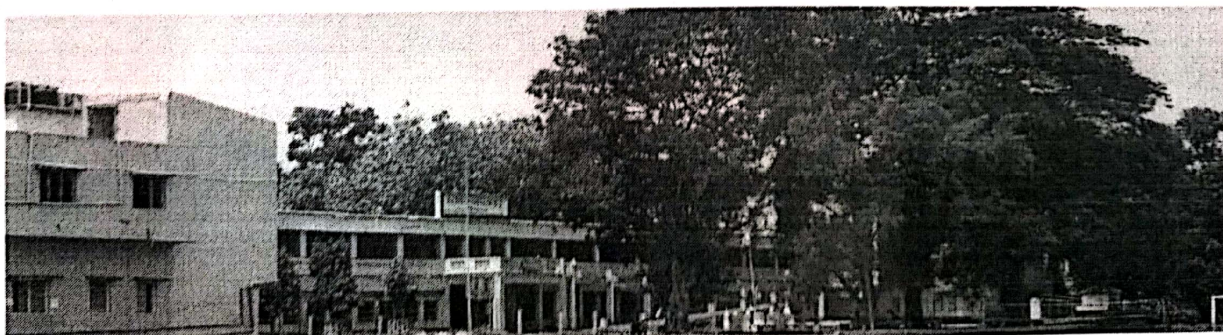

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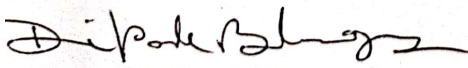

A Free Medical Health Camp

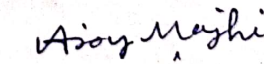

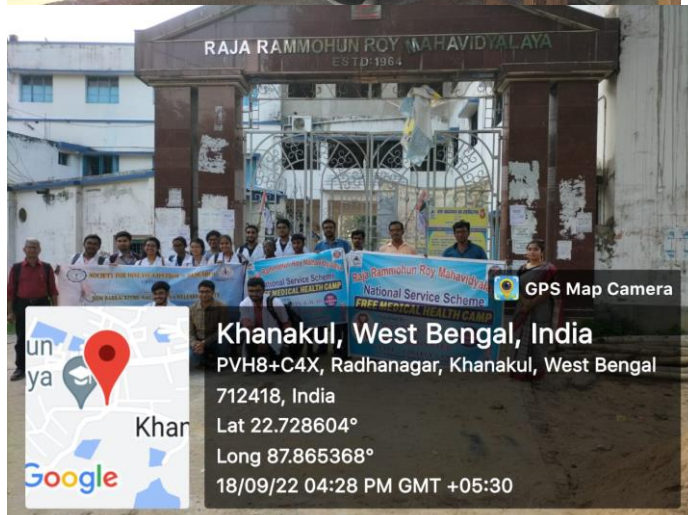
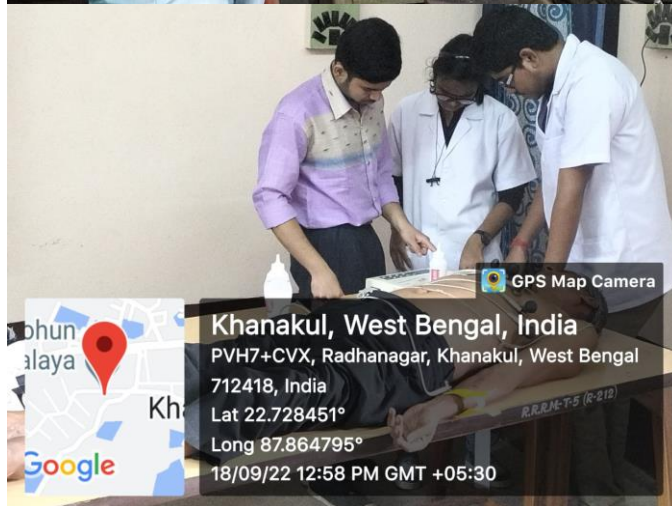

Consolidated Report for “Har Ghar Tiranga”
Programme- Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM)

The Cadets of NCC (National Cadet Corps) under the guidance of the ANO (Associated NCC Officer) of lieutenant Rank and the volunteers of 3 NSS units under the active guidance of the Programme Officers of Raja Rammohun Roy Mahavidyalaya, as per the instruction of the University Grants Commission had initiated the ‘**Har Ghar Tiranga**’ campaign under the aegis of **Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav** to encourage people to bring the Tiranga home and to hoist it to mark the 75th year of India’s independence. The students of our college had actively participated in the ‘Har Ghar Tiranga’ campaign.

Programme on 13th of August, 2022

We had planned the programme to sensitize the students of the primary school and the people of the village of the Paschim Radhanagar of Khanakul, Hooghly. The Programme had started on 13th of August, 2022 and continued till 15th August, 2022. All the students had started the campaign from the college at 9.00 a.m. to visit the village of Paschim Radhanagar, where they had visited the primary school and also to the homes of the local peoples of the village to make them understand of our commitment to nation-building. The plan behind the program is to raise the feeling of patriotism in the hearts of the inhabitants of the village and the small children’s of the school to promote awareness about the Indian National Flag. 138 students had participated in the programme

After reaching the school all the students of our college had started the campaign with the school teachers and the students by hoisting the Tiranga and singing the National Anthem “Jana Gana Mana” After that the Teachers of our college had given a nice presentation in their local language regarding the importance of the National Flag. They had also said the real meaning of the Independence and the students of the school vary patiently observe their presentation. They had also been sensitized about the freedom struggle our country had gone through and achieve this Independence. They had

also been clarified and made understand about the word “Vande Mataram” , which is basically a poem written by Bankim Chandra Chatterjee. The importance of the National Flag of our country had also been said in detail in the easiest possible way to the children’s of the school. Moreover from the college National Flag of our country had been distributed among the students and had also been asked to hoist the National Flag in their house. At the end of the campaign on behalf of the college some sweets and snacks were also distributed among the small children’s of the school.

Programme on 14th of August, 2022:

The Cadets of NCC (National Cadet Corps) under the guidance of the ANO (Associated NCC Officer) of lieutenant Rank and the volunteers of 3 NSS units under the active guidance of the Programme Officers of Raja Rammohun Roy Mahavidyalaya, as per the instruction of the University Grants Commission planned an awareness programme on ‘Importance and Meaning of colours of the Indian National Flag as part of the movement ‘Har Ghar Tiranga’ under the aegis of Azadi ka Amrut Mahaotsav. 117 students participated in the session.

On 14th of August, 2022, all the students had started the campaign from the college at 9.00 a.m. to visit the house of the local people of the village. The programme officers of the 3 units of the NSS (National Service Scheme) of our college had provided a detailed account of the development of the flag and the shifting contours of its representation. They had also explained the role of Mahatma Gandhi in the design of the flag and the momentum it gave to the freedom movement. Next the volunteers of the NSS had said about the history of the selection of the colours and the meanings attached with them: saffron for courage, white for peace, green for prosperity and the Ashoka wheel for dynamism and strength.

The NCC cadets had also explained the symbolism of the flag and its part in inducing the feeling of courage and noble sacrifice in face of adversity. By putting a spotlight on the colours and the importance attached with them, they pointed out the traits expected of a perfect civilian. At the end of the programme few National flags of our country were distributed among the people of the village.

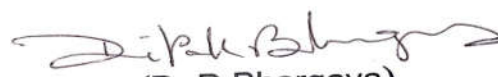
Programme on 15th of August, 2022:

Raja Rammohun Roy Mahavidyalaya, of Khanakul, Hooghly had celebrated the 75th Independence Day of the Nation on 15th August 2022 with due splendor and reverence. Both staff and the students had participated in the celebrations.

The celebrations commenced with the flag hoisting ceremony. Dr. Dipak Bhargava, Principal was escorted by the two NCC cadets to the flag podium and the flag was hoisted by the Principal with due respect. On the occasion the national anthem was sung by the students and the staff of our college. Following the hoisting the NCC cadets and the volunteers of the 3 units of the NSS had organized a March in the surrounding areas with band, flag in hands and chanting Vande Matram. During this March the importance of this Independence Day was explained to the people.

Report for Lecture Series on "Partition Horror Remembrance Day"

Raja Rammohun Roy Mahavidyalaya as a part of 75 years of Indian Independence as Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav organize a Lecture series on " Partition Horror Remembrance Day" with the volunteers of 3 NSS units and the cadets of NCC under the active guidance of their 3 Programme officers and the ANO (Associated NCC Officer) of lieutenant Rank. This lecture series is undertaken under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahaotsav to let the students and the faculty members know about the impacts of Partition on our country. The students of our college had actively participated in this lecture series.

At the beginning day Dr. Subrata Kumar De of Department of Bengali had actively analysed the psychological impact of partition on the people of our undivided country and later he had also beautifully presented the impacts of Partition in this part of Bengal, which is now known as West Bengal.

One the second day Prof. Saifuddin Mondal of Department of History had delivered the lecture on the historical impact of partition not only for the countries which are going to be divided but also emphasized on the impact of Manmade border and their hindrance hence forth to meet with their fellow citizens who had been divided by this partition. Prof. Saifuddin Mondal had categorically presented the impact of partition on the people of undivided Punjab part which had been later been divided.

On the penultimate day Prof. Jayants Das of Department of Political Science had beautifully presented the impact of partition on the Governance. He had lucidly presented the arise of two new countries once which are united and what are the difficulties people had to face on the Governance front due to this partition.

On the last day Dr. Sk. Maidul Islam of Department of Political Science had categorically and effectively presented the role of the then political leaders on the partition and also the role of the British Government on the partition. Dr. Islam had beautifully placed that the British Government had played an very effective role on creating this partition.
