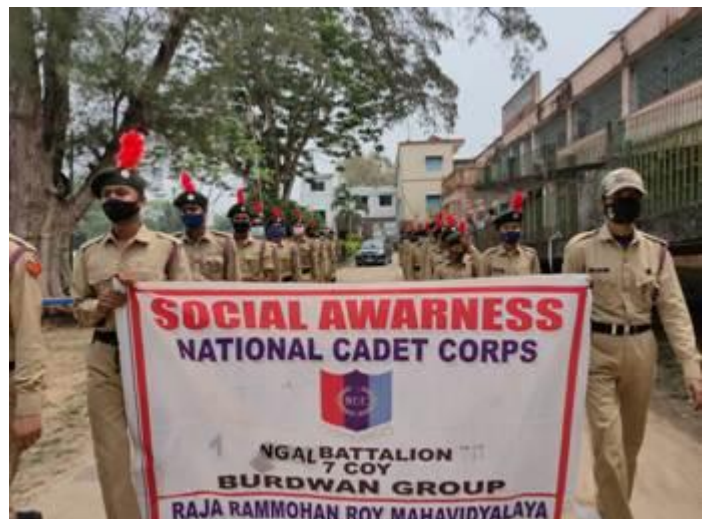

Campus Cleaning Programme:
