TITLE OF THE COURSE- ADVANCED SANSKRIT GRAMMAR.

## Course Details:

The proposed course attempts to simplify the grammar with a specific focus on Naam, Sarvanaam, Vachan, Linga, Purusha, etc which are considered as cornerstones of Paniniyan Grammar. The course is mainly designed for 1st year students but it is also perfect for Sanskrit lovers without any prior knowledge of the subject.

## Course Objectives:

- To learn the Sanskrit language with a constructivist approach.
- The course focuses on four language skills viz listening, speaking, reading, and writing in Sanskrit.

## Course Content:

Concepts of person, number, gender, Tense, Mode, sentence construction, Complex sentence construction in Sanskrit language.

## Outcomes:

On successful completion of the course, students should be able to - read Sanskrit texts, recite Sanskrit subhashit and stotras, and form simple and complex sentences in Sanskrit. They can write in Devanagari scripts well. They can able to interact with others in Sanskrit.

Course Duration: 20 hours/ semester

## **Details of Syllabus:**

- संज्ञापरिभाषाप्रकरणम्- an Overview of Definition and Paribhasha according to Paniniyan Grammar.
- अव्ययप्रकरणम्- Details knowledge of Abyaya and usage of Abyaya in Sanskrit texts.
- कारकप्रकरणम्- Details knowledge of Karaka according to Paniniyan Grammar.
- अनुवादज्ञानम् – Knowledge of making sentences in Sanskrit.

**Evaluation:** After completion of the course a Written exam of 50 marks will be taken.

**Eligibility:** The course is aimed at those who want to learn Sanskrit mainly Honours students.
