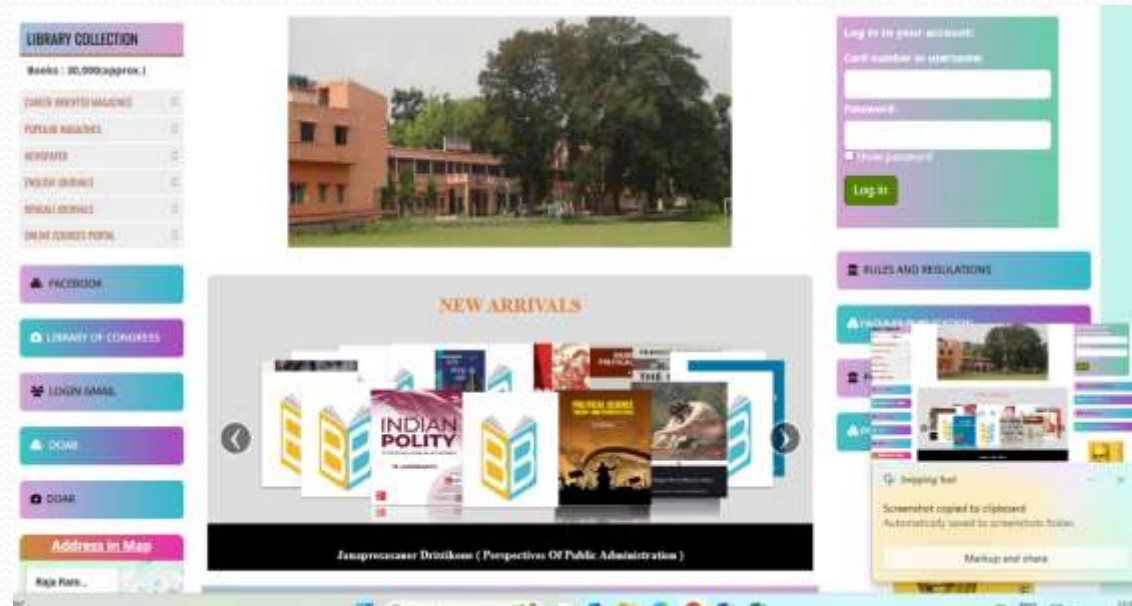

The reading room open on all working days from 10.00 am to 5:00 pm (only up to 2:00pm on Saturday) and The Circulation section remain open on all working days from 10.00 am to 3:00 pm (only up to 1:00 pm on Saturday) except on Sunday , scheduled National and other holidays of the College and University.

LIBRARY RULES- GENERAL

1. Students are not allowed in the Library without Library card.
2. Library card is issued on producing the original admission pay slip.
3. The borrower is responsible for borrowed book/books.
4. Books borrowed against the card must be returned within 30 days.
5. Loss of Library card must be reported to the Librarian immediately.

- TOTAL AREA OF THE LIBRARY: 318 SQ MTS.
- LIBRARY ROOM AND STACKS: 142 SQ.
- ADDL. BOOK STACKING ROOM: 118 SQ M.
- READING ROOM: 49 SQ M

Library Collections

Reference Books : There is a collection of conventional reference books like General Dictionary, Geographical Dictionary Encyclopedia, etc. for ready reference and general information.

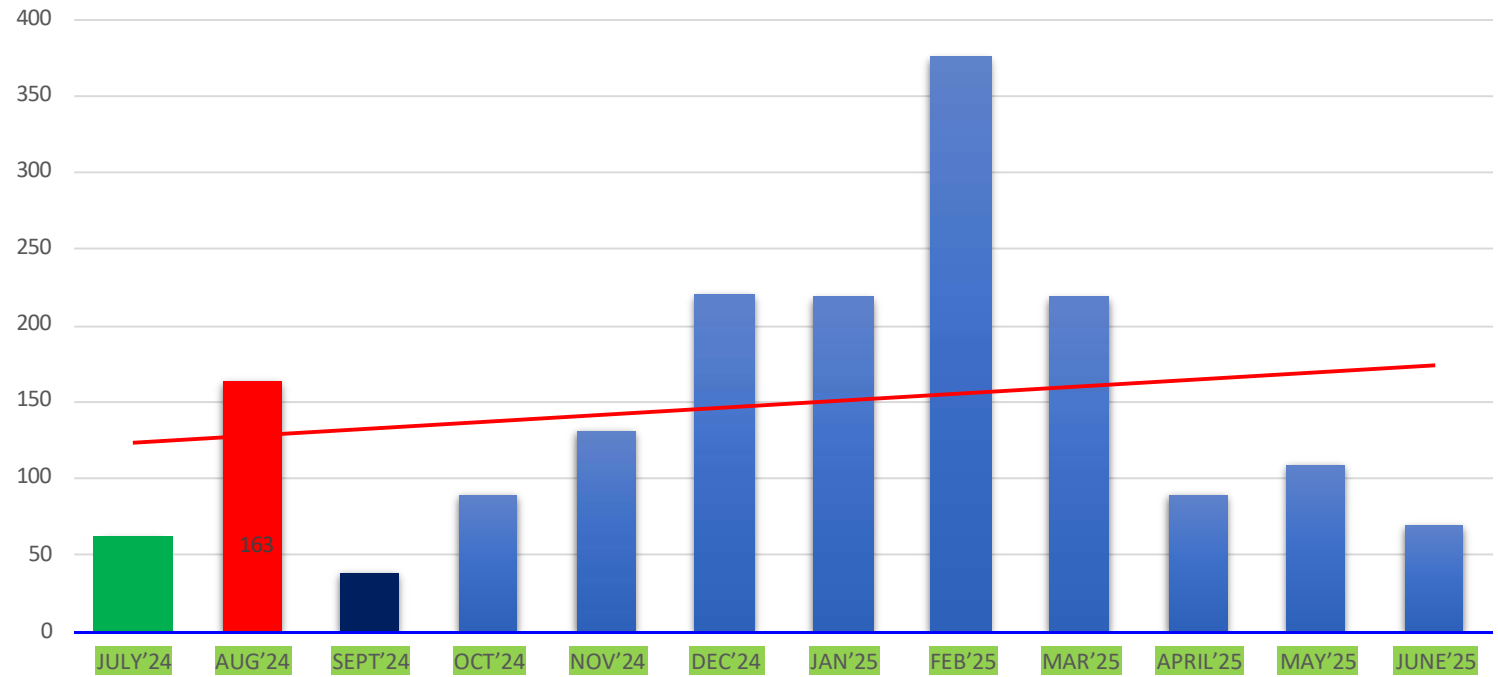

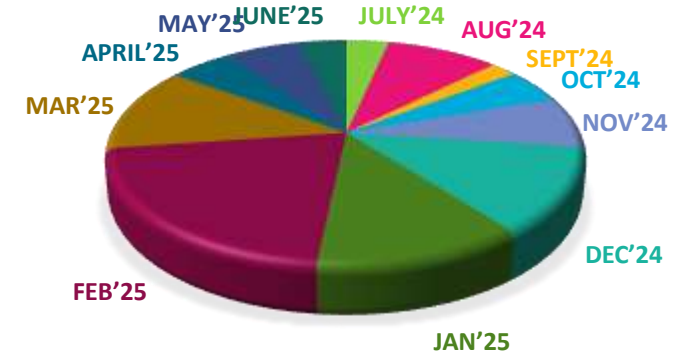

The library provides lending service, through charging and discharging of books to the users. It gives Home issue of 3 Books for 30 days.

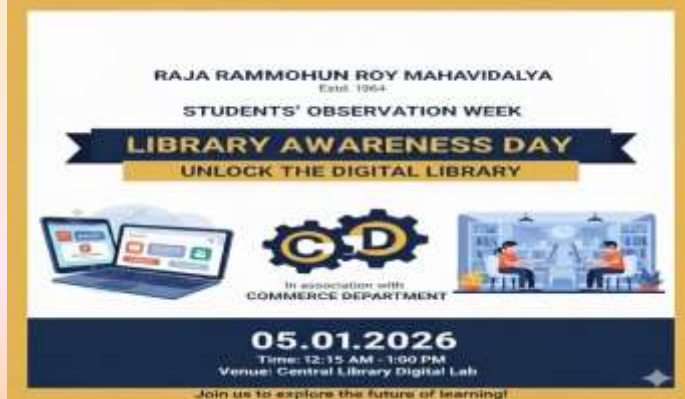
Reference Service :
